- Remove the door and locate the quick-connect inside the fixture. Complete the wiring to the appropriate supply wires. Connect fixture leads to power supply leads using the appropriate connectors (connections are made in the junction box, not the fixture). Be sure to connect the grounding wire to a suitable ground.
- Place fixture in place (typically over an existing electrical junction box). Locate and drill pilot holes in mounting surface using the base plate as a template. Using fasteners/anchors appropriate for the mounting surface and fixture weight, (supplied by others), mount the fixture base.
- Run wiring leads into fixture and make the connections.
- Complete installation by replacing door and hand-tighten the fasteners.

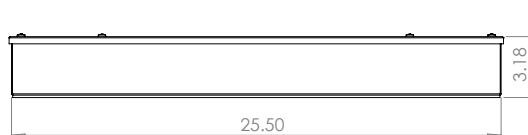
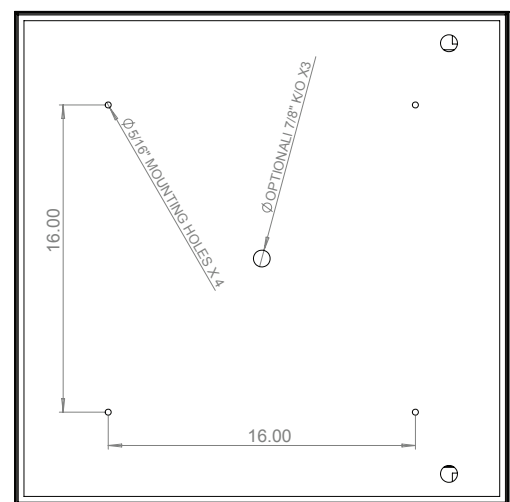
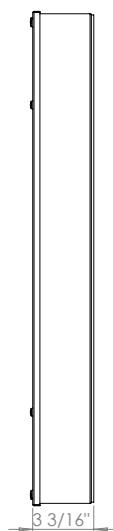
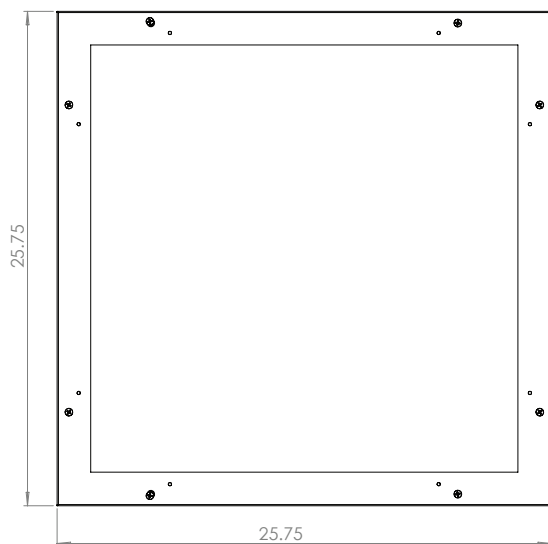




1X4 ENCLOSURE
