IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS






REMINDER: TO AVOID ELECTRIC SHOCK HAZARD, DISCONNECT THE POWER AT THE PANEL BOARD (CIRCUIT BOX) BEFORE BEGINNING INSTALLATION!



Carefully remove fixture from packaging. Use gloves to prevent dirt and oils from transferring to the unit. Inspect the fixture for any defects before proceeding.




CAUTION: EDGES MAY BE SHARP:
Carefully remove lens from fixture
(using provided suction cups) gently
un-snapping one side at a time, and set
lens aside. Leave the suction cups
on the lens.



Remove LED assembly (it will hang from tethers) and set aside.




7/8" knockout is located on the back of the fixture to allow for wiring. Bring wiring through.




Mount fixture to surface by installing screws through .25" holes (or keyways if applicable) located on back of fixture.







Wire fixture according to all national, state and local codes. Re-install LED assembly and test fixture.



CAUTION: EDGES MAY BE SHARP:

Attach suction cups to the face of the lens (if you need to reposition the lens or remove and start over, the suction cups give you valuble gripping points on the lens)

Carefully re-insert lens by gently squeezing the sides of the lens and reinsert into the housing - snapping in one side at a time. The lens WILL FIT FLUSH WITH THE SURFACE OF THE HOUSING.
